RESOLVED, That the action of this Board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth, effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for the following additions, Amendment Codes 260-1 through 260-3 which shall take effect immediately; to provide for the following revisions, Amendment Codes 260-11 through 260-24 which shall take effect immediately; to provide for the following abolishments, Amendment Codes 260-25 through 260-39 which shall also take effect immediately; and to provide for the following revisions, Amendment Codes 260-4 through 260-10 which shall take effect May 20, 1971, in all agencies for which this is the beginning of a pay period, and on the first full pay period following May 20, 1971, in all other agencies; and be it further
