



RESOLVED, That the action of this Board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth, effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for the following additions, Amendment Codes 276-1 through 276-12 which shall take effect immediately; and to provide for the following revisions, Amendment Codes 276-13 through 276-20 which shall take effect on the first full pay period following June 2, 1972; and Amendment Code 276-21 which shall take effect on February 16, 1972; and to provide for the following revisions, Amendment Codes 276-22 and 276-23 which shall take effect June 15, 1972; and to provide for the following revisions and abolitions, Amendment Codes 276-24 through 276-56 which shall take effect immediately.
