WHEREAS, A collective bargaining agreement between the Commonwealth and the Retail Clerks Union, Pennsylvania State Store Organizing Committee, AFL-CIO, is imminent encompassing the non-supervisory Liquor Store Clerks Unit; and

WHEREAS, The Commonwealth entered into a memorandum of understanding with the Independent Association of Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board Employes on September 5, 1973, encompassing the first level supervisory Liquor Store Managers; and

WHEREAS, The above mentioned labor agreements stipulate general pay increases effective July 1, 1973; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 709(a) of the Administrative Code of 1929, as amended, the action of this board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth, effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for revisions on Amendment 306 and the revised pay schedule which are attached hereto and made part of this resolution; and be it further

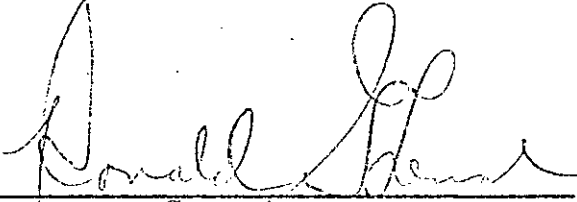
RESOLVED, That the employes covered by the contract for non-supervisory Liquor Store Clerks Unit shall receive a \$.40 per hour general pay increase or receive the rates for their class as set forth in the revised schedule, whichever is greater, effective July 1, 1973, except as provided below; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the employes covered by the memorandum of understanding for the first level supervisory Liquor Store Managers Unit shall receive a general pay increase in accordance with the rates for their class as set forth in the revised schedule, effective July 1, 1973, except as provided below and be it further

RESOLVED, That employes on leave without pay or educational leave with pay shall receive the general pay increase upon return to active status; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be effective July 1, 1973; and be it further
