WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Labor Relations Board in its order dated September 5, 1978, directed that the class Liquor Store Clerk 2 be placed in the Liquor Store Clerks non-supervisory unit, and that the classes Liquor Store Manager 1, 2, 3, and 4 and Liquor Store General Manager 1 remain in the Liquor Store Managers supervisory unit, and that part of the class Liquor Store General Manager 2 be placed in the Liquor Store Managers supervisory unit and that part be placed in the State Stores Management unit, and that the class Liquor Store General Manager 3 be placed in the State Stores Management unit; and

WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has agreed with the Independent Association of Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board Employees encompassing the supervisory Liquor Store Managers unit to grant general pay increases effective July 1, 1978, and January 1, 1979, that are equivalent to those applied to the Standard Pay Schedule; and

WHEREAS, Employees in the State Stores Management unit should receive the general pay increases equivalent to those applied to the Standard Pay Schedule to maintain equity; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 709(a) of The Administrative Code of 1929, the action of this Board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for Amendment No. 371 and the Liquor Store Managers and Warehouse Personnel Pay Schedules and the Liquor Store General Managers Pay Schedules effective July 1, 1978, and January 1, 1979, which are attached and made part of this resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, That employees in an active pay status in the above employe units covered by the attached pay schedules shall receive the general pay increases applied to the respective pay schedules effective July 1, 1978, and January 1, 1979, without changes in anniversary dates; and be it further

RESOLVED, That employees on leave without pay shall receive the appropriate general pay increases upon return to active pay status; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the pay rate established by this Board effective July 1, 1977, for the class Liquor Store Clerk II shall remain in effect until that pay rate is changed through collective bargaining and revised by this Board; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this resolution shall be effective September 5, 1978, for Amendment No. 371 and July 1, 1978, and January 1, 1979, for the respective pay schedules; and be it further
