RESOLVED, That the contents of Chapters 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 19, and 20 and Sections 21.2 and 21.4 shall be deleted from 4 Pennsylvania Code and the appropriate chapter and section numbers be reserved; and be it further

RESOLVED, That amendments and revisions to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Pay Plan, M525.2, shall be deposited with the Legislative Reference Bureau to be filed, but not published, under the provisions of 1 Pennsylvania Code §3.13(b); and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Pay Plan shall be distributed to state agencies through the Directives Management System and the information contained therein shall be available to the public through the Bureau of Personnel, Office of Budget and Administration; and be it further

RESOLVED, That notice of proposed rule making pursuant to Sections 201 and 202 of the Commonwealth Documents Law (45 P.S. Section 1201 and 1202) is omitted in accordance with Section 204 of CDL (45 P.S. Section 1204), as this resolution relates only to Commonwealth organization, management or personnel matters.
