WHEREAS, The classification and pay staff of the Governor's Office has conducted comprehensive studies of prevailing pay scales in private industry and other public jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, The findings of these studies reveal that the pay ranges of virtually all classes in the Commonwealth's Compensation Plan need to be adjusted in order that the Commonwealth may maintain a competitive position in the labor market; and

WHEREAS, These studies also reveal that the current average salary level of Commonwealth employes lags behind those of other comparable state jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, The Governor, in recognition of these circumstances has authorized a general pay increase of approximately five percent for Commonwealth employes; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 709(a) of The Administrative Code of 1929, as amended, the action of this Board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for the following revisions shown on Amendment No. 169, which is attached hereto and made part of this resolution; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That every employe who occupies a permanent position allocated to a class in the Compensation Plan and whose salary or wage is below the revised minimum rate for his class shall receive a pay increase to the new minimum rate; if the pay adjustment amounts to two steps or more, the employe's anniversary date shall change, and he will not be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment prior to the beginning of the first full payroll period in January, 1968; if the increase to the new minimum rate amounts to only one step, the employe's anniversary date shall not change and he will be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment on his anniversary date; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That every such permanent employe whose salary or wage is equal to or higher than the new minimum rate for his class, but below the old maximum rate for his class, shall receive a pay increase of one step; his anniversary date shall not change, and he will be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment on his anniversary date; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That every such permanent employe whose salary or wage is at the old maximum rate for his class shall receive a pay increase of one step; if the employe's salary has been at the old maximum rate for one year or more and the pay range of his class is increased by two or more ranges, he shall be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment on the beginning of the first full pay period in July, 1967; if his salary has been at the old maximum rate for less than one year and the pay range of his class is increased by two or more pay ranges, he shall be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment not

earlier than one year from the date of his last meritorious increase, or on the beginning of the first full pay period in July, 1967, whichever date is later; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That any such permanent employe whose salary or wage is above the old maximum rate for his class shall receive a pay increase of one step, provided, however, that in no case shall an employe's salary be increased above the new maximum rate for his class; if the employe's new salary is below the new maximum rate for his class, he will be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment on the beginning of the first full pay period in January, 1968; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That any such permanent employe whose pay range does not change shall receive a pay increase of one step; if the employe's new salary is below the maximum of the pay range, his anniversary date shall not change and he will be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment on his anniversary date; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That any such permanent employe whose salary is at a half-increment step on the Special Schedule of Pay Ranges for Maintenance Offset Purposes, approved by this Board on September 15, 1966, shall receive a salary increase to that full step within the new pay range assigned to his class which will provide an increase of at least one full increment; provided, however, that in no case shall an employe's salary be increased above the maximum of his new pay range; if the pay adjustment amounts to two pay steps or more, the employe's anniversary date shall change and he will not be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment prior to the beginning of the first full payroll period in January, 1968; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the above provisions regarding the changing of anniversary dates shall not apply to the faculty members of the State Colleges and Indiana University of Pennsylvania, who shall be eligible to be considered for a meritorious increment at the beginning of the 1967-68 school year; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the members of the permanent maintenance force of the Department of Highways and other permanent wage employes who are paid at fixed hourly or per diem rates shall receive a pay increase of one step; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That every employe who occupies a temporary position allocated to a class in the Compensation Plan and whose salary or wage is below the revised minimum rate for his class shall receive a pay increase to the new minimum rate; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That every such temporary employe whose salary or wage is equal to or higher than the new minimum rate for his class shall not be eligible to receive a general pay increase under the provisions of this resolution; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the above provisions of this resolution shall not apply to employes who are not paid in accordance with the Compensation Plan; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That employes who are on leave of absence without pay on January 1, 1967, shall receive the general pay increase, in accordance with the rules outlined above, upon their return to active status; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become effective January 1, 1967; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That, in those agencies which have a regular pay period beginning December 31, 1966, employes who do not work a regular Monday to Friday work-week shall, for purposes of this general pay increase, be assumed to have worked ten work days from January 1, 1967 to the end of the payroll period; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That in those agencies in which funds may not be available for payment of any of the increases provided above, the increases shall become effective January 1, 1967; but payment of the increases shall not be made until funds become available.
