WHEREAS, The Governor has directed the Pennsylvania State Police to initiate a program that would assure that all applicants for State Police employment be assessed on the basis of their ability to meet relevant job requirements; and

WHEREAS, The Department of State Police and the Office of Administration, Bureau of Personnel, have completed a study of the job content and requirements of the Pennsylvania State Police Cadet and Trooper in cooperation with the State Civil Service Commission, and the Manpower Management Institute; and

WHEREAS, Job-related required knowledges, skills, and abilities have been identified and minimum training requirements have been established as a result of this study; and

WHEREAS, The classification specifications for State Police Cadet and Trooper have been revised to reflect these job-related requirements; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the action of this Board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth, effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for the following revisions, Amendment Codes 320-1 and 320-2 which shall be effective immediately; and be it further

RESOLVED, That notice of proposed rule making pursuant to Sections 201 and 202 of the Commonwealth Documents Law (45 P.S. Sections 1201 and 1202) is omitted in accordance with Section 204 of CDL (45 P.S. Section 1204), as this resolution relates only to Commonwealth organization, management or personnel matters.
