WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 709(a) of the Administrative Code, this Board adopted a Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth on July 13, 1956, effective August 1, 1956; and

WHEREAS, This Compensation Plan has been amended at different times since its adoption to place the salary ranges of various classes on a more competitive basis with the pay scales in private industry and other public jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Studies of comparative pay data received from private and public employers reveal that the salary ranges of many classes in the Compensation Plan which were not included in previous amendments to the Plan need to be adjusted at this time, and that the pay ranges of other classes are in need of further revision; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the action of this Board taken on July 13, 1956, approving a Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth, effective August 1, 1956, be further revised in accordance with the additions and revisions provided in Amendment No. 53, which is attached hereto and made part of this resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this action shall take effect on December 14, 1960 in all agencies for which this is the beginning of a pay period and on the beginning of the pay period following December 14, 1960, in all other agencies.
