WHEREAS, The classification and pay staff of the Governor's Office has conducted comprehensive studies of prevailing salary scales in private industry and among comparable public jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, The findings of these studies reveal that the pay ranges of a large number of classes in the Commonwealth's Compensation Plan need to be adjusted in order that the Commonwealth's competitive position in the labor market may be maintained; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 709(a) of the Administrative Code of 1929, the action of this Board taken July 13, 1956, approving the Compensation Plan for the Commonwealth effective August 1, 1956, be amended to provide for the revisions shown on Amendment Number 88, which is attached hereto and made part of this resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, That these revisions shall take effect on November 22, 1963, in all agencies for which this is the beginning of a pay period and on the beginning of the first full pay period following November 22, 1963, in all other agencies.
